| The participants arrived to the IIS ' <i>Tonino Guerra</i> ' Alberghiero Institute school where they were welcomed by the students. The councillor for schools and culture, Cesare Zavatta, together with Scilla Reali, headmaster of the Institute, gave a welcoming speech to all participants. | | | |
| The European projects office of the Municipality of Cervia organised and coordinated the final conference. Simona Melchiorri, coordinator and head of the office, explained the project agenda and the objectives of the event. | | | |
| The first session of the conference was held by the lead partner who explained the achievements of the project during the previous events and outlined the <i>Official Declaration</i> about how local communities and youth can contribute to the European Green Deal as response to the COVID19 crisis. | | | |
| The event kicked off at the IIS ' <i>Tonino Guerra</i> ' where the partner delegations together with a group of students from the Institute took part in two interactive English-language workshops on two topical issues facing the European community. | | | |
| During the first session, the topic tackled was climate change with Prof. Sandro Fuzzi Dirigente di Ricerca - Istituto di Scienze dell'Atmosfera e del Clima - Consiglio Nazionale delle Ricerche (Bologna), who illustrated the ' <i>Brief history of climate change: causes, effects, current conditions and possible counteracting actions</i> '. | | | |
| The speech provided the elements for discussing and reflecting on the cornerstones of the European Green Deal, set down at the local level to counter this global challenge. The workshop was an opportunity to involve students in order to understand, through their valuable testimonies and awareness, what actions can be taken also in everyday activities to foster the green transition. | | | |
| The second working session included the participation of Librazione in coordination with Europe Direct Romagna, which held an informative session on voting in view of the forthcoming European elections. They explained the European institutions, their role, and what it is for to attend and vote. | | | |
| It was an opportunity to shed light on the importance of the right/duty to vote, with the intention of | | | |

raising the awareness of the students present, who are being called upon for the first time to cast their vote in this very important matter.

The session then simulated potential candidates in the race to become the new members of the European Parliament, who prepared their programmes on a number of common issues and then presented them to the audience, who were then called upon to vote on the most convincing proposal.



In the afternoon, the delegations were taken on a cultural Eductour of Cervia “*Tackling the relationship between men and environment*” by visiting the cultural and historical heritage and the most representative sites such as the Musa - Salt Museum and the San Michele Tower.

18/04/2024

During the second day of work, the delegations visited the Cervia Social Food project in the Cervia artisanal area where, for more than two years, volunteers have continued to carry out various activities in the field of solidarity and hospitality. In particular, the delegations were able to get to know at first hand the several actions that the volunteers promote in helping those most in need.

In the run-up to Europe Day, a video recording was made in which the project partners read the Schuman Declaration in their mother tongue at Radio Social Coast. The video recording will then be broadcast via web radio on 9 May.



The conclusion of the activities took place at Scambiamenti - Cultural Space, a place for the dissemination of culture, the exchange of ideas and experiences, where operators and volunteers organise activities to support and disseminate knowledge in all its forms: from Italian and foreign language lessons, to the presentation of books, to the exhibition of modern and contemporary works of art by local artists.

On that occasion, the lead partner presented to all delegations the draft commitment concerning the sustainability declaration between the partners concerning the actions to be implemented after the end of the project.

The commitment will then be shared and signed by all for the enhancement of the network created by the project, relying on future collaboration and dissemination of the results obtained.
